Objective: In this session different method of field work in research was widely explained by Dr. Sunny Jaiswal that involves collecting raw data in a natural setting, outside of a lab.





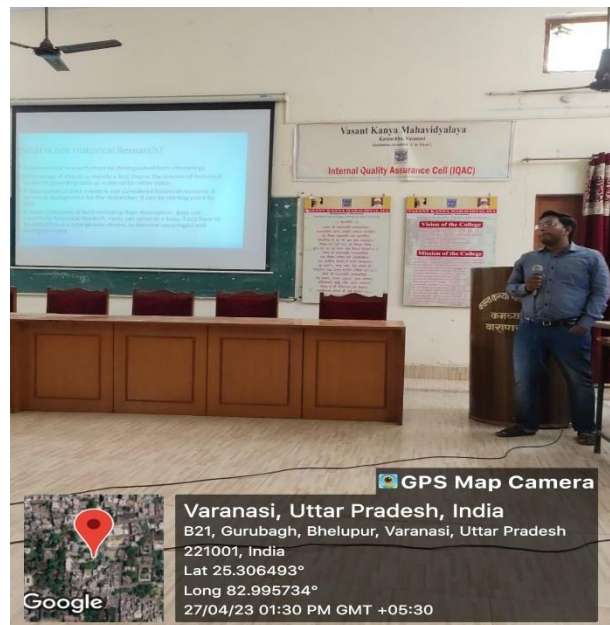

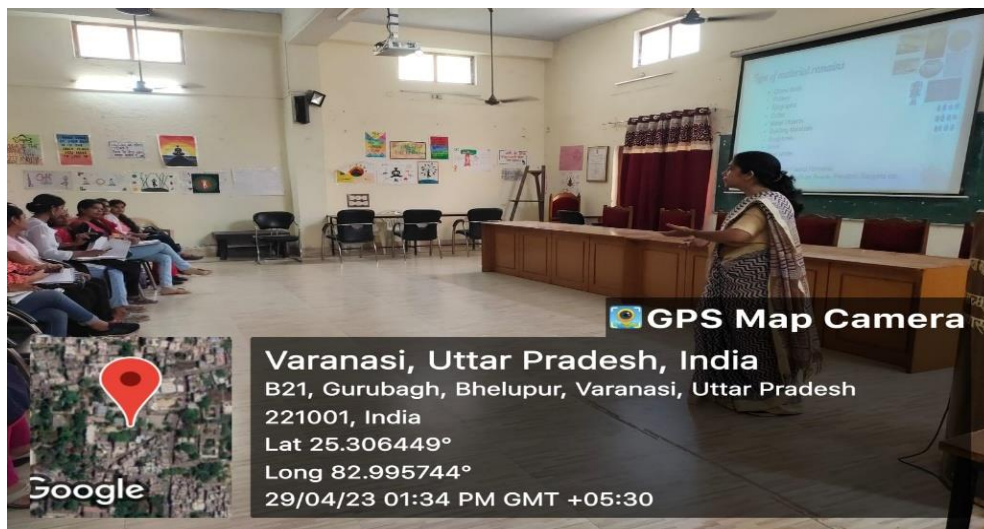
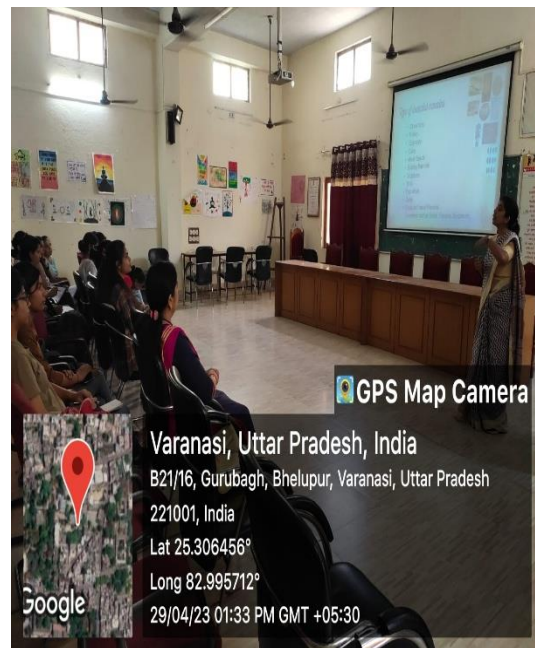

Objective: The problems in Archaeology was thoroughly described by Dr. Arti Kumari in which problems faced by historians and archaeologist while analysing the data was widely explained .



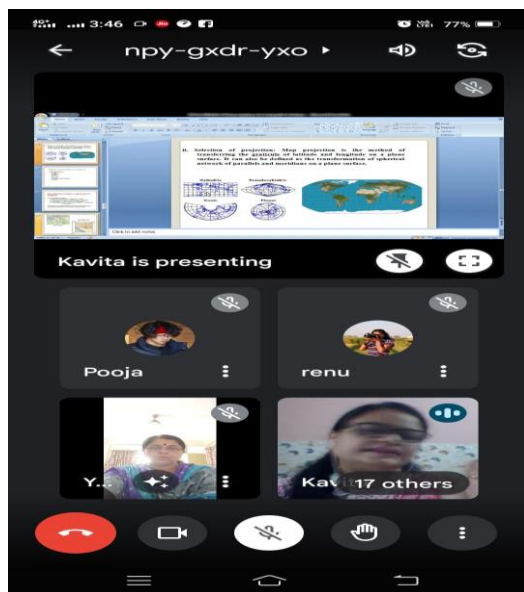

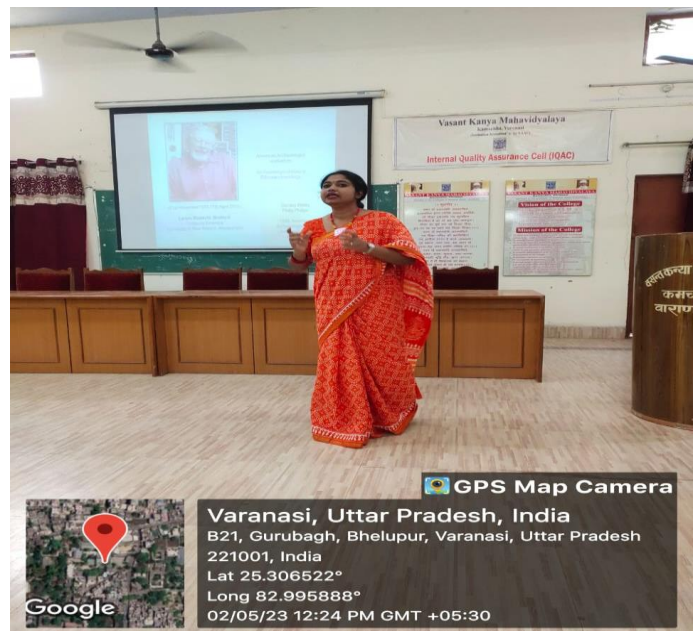
